

Sailor's Hornpipe

Irish Traditional; arr. AEGriffiths

This tune is in a Two-Part Form.
This means that there are 2 big sections.
These are labeled as section A and section B.
Each section is repeated.
The tune is played all the way through and then
we go through the whole tune again but with a **VARIATION**
on each of the 2 sections.

The musical score is written in G major (one sharp) and 4/4 time. It consists of the following parts:

- Section A:** Measures 1-8. Ends with a first ending (1.) and a second ending (2.).
- Section B:** Measures 9-12. Ends with a first ending (1.) and a second ending (2.).
- Section A Variation:** Measures 17-20. A variation of the first section.
- Section B Variation:** Measures 25-28. A variation of the second section.

Measure numbers 5, 9, 13, 17, 21, 25, and 29 are indicated at the start of their respective lines.
