


Chromatic Scale, Enharmonics, and Accidentals



Flat symbol Natural symbol Sharp symbol




All notes have two different names. The note A# is the exact same pitch and fingering as Bb, C# is the same as Db, etc:

A# = Bb C# = Db D# = Eb F# = Gb



Chromatic scale for one octave - from A to A:



Accidentals last throughout the measure, unless indicated otherwise:

Play Bb throughout this measure.

Play Bb until beat 3, where the natural sign happens.
